

**Fulton County Government Statement to Active Employees and Retirees**  
**on Anthem (Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia) Cyber Attack**

**Today [Feb. 5, 2015] Fulton County Government was advised** that Anthem, Inc., the parent company of our health insurance provider Blue Cross Blue Shield of GA, is the victim of a highly-sophisticated cyber attack.

Anthem has informed us that its member data was accessed, and could include that of our employees.

Below is an update with information available so far:

- Anthem immediately notified federal law enforcement officials of the cyber attack, and has taken steps to eliminate the breach and secure its data.
- Anthem immediately began a forensic IT investigation to determine the number of impacted consumers and to identify the type of information accessed. The investigation is still taking place.
- The information accessed includes member names, member health ID numbers/Social Security numbers, dates of birth, addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses and employment information, including income data. Some Social Security numbers were included, but not for all of the affected customers.
- Anthem is still working to determine which members' Social Security numbers were accessed.
- Anthem's investigation to date shows that no credit card or confidential health information was accessed.
- Anthem has advised us there is no indication at this time that any personal information has been misused.
- All impacted Anthem members will be enrolled in identity repair services. In addition, impacted members will be provided information on how to enroll in free credit monitoring.

We are continuing to work closely with Anthem to better understand the cyber attack and the impact on our employees. Anthem has created a website – [www.anthemfacts.com](http://www.anthemfacts.com), and a hotline, 1-877-263-7995, for its members to call for more information, and has shared the attached Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) that further explains the cyber attack.
