Pension Board meetings continue to be teleconferenced via Zoom. The next meeting will be September 13, 2023.

Minutes of the July 13, 2023 meeting were ratified.

• The Board approved **6** new pension applications:

Sheriff: Serena Spikes
Superior Court: Monical Smith
Tax Commissioner: Andrew Stephens

Beneficiaries: Linda Barnett, Ubon Shaw, Sharon York

- Bryce Riddle reported a fund balance of \$1,417,018,487 as of June 30, 2023. Fulton County has contributed \$34,304,430 as of the same date.
- Bryce Riddle reported that there are currently **3,051** retirees, and **89** active employees in the Defined Benefit plan (**14** of those are fully vested).
- The Board of County Commissioners will discuss the recommendation from the Pension Board to convert Trustee Position # 8 to a position which can be occupied by either an active or retired participant of the Defined Benefit Plan at their meeting on August 16, 2023.
- The Investment Committee reported a **3.1%**_increase (net of fees) for the month of July. For the one -year period, the system returned 11.0%, outperforming the Allocation Index, which returned 8.5%, and the Policy Index, which returned 8.6%.
- A reminder was given to Trustees about the GAPPT Trustee School coming up September 18-20 in Athens. Elaine Greer
 will now Chair the Education Committee and will track the hours required by the State for trustees to maintain their
 position on this Board.
- Keith Stronkowsky of NEPC provided the quarterly report on our plan:
 - ❖ As of June 30, 2023, the Plan's assets increased approximately \$41.6 million during the quarter
 - ❖ The Plan posted a 4.75% return during the guarter, ranking in the 8th percentile of public funds
 - 1-year annualized returns through June 30, 2023, were 13.5%

- 3-year annualized returns through June 30, 2023, were 7.9%
- 5-year annualized returns through June 30, 2023, were 6.6%
- The strongest returns during the last quarter came from the Total Large Cap Composite
